Resolution No. 2007-1096

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of the Lakehaven Utility District, King County, Washington, proposing a street lighting system for certain areas within the District and fixing a time and place for a public hearing on said proposed street lighting system.

WHEREAS, the District is authorized, pursuant to R.C.W. 57.08.060, to provide street lighting service for residents within the boundaries of the Lakehaven Utility District, and

WHEREAS, residents within the below described parcel of realty have petitioned the District to provide street lighting service;

NOW, THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** that:

1. The Board of Commissioners hereby proposes the establishment of a street lighting system to serve the following described real property:

8th Avenue Southwest and Southwest 313th Court

2. That the property owners served by said street lighting will pay to the District, upon the effective date of the provision of service and each month thereafter, such sum as shall from time to time be determined by the Board of Commissioners for operation and maintenance.

3. That a public hearing concerning the providing of this service by the Lakehaven Utility District be held at 6:30 p.m. on December 13, 2007, at 31531 1st Avenue South, Federal Way, Washington.

The Secretary of this Board is hereby authorized and instructed to cause notice of the adoption of this Resolution to be given by publication as required by law.
