Resolution No. 2004-1020

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of the Lakehaven Utility District, King County, Washington, modifying the Customer Assistance Program and amending Lakehaven Utility District No. 2002-976.

WHEREAS, the Board has previously established a Customer Assistance Program to help customers experiencing financial difficulties pay delinquent residential water and/or sewer accounts, and

WHEREAS, over the course of administering the Customer Assistance Program, the funds available to help customers in need have not been sufficient to meet the demand for assistance, and

WHEREAS, the Board believes that the program should be available to as many customers as possible, and

WHEREAS, in order to provide benefits to more customers, it is necessary to limit the amount of funds which may be applied to individual accounts and the frequency with which benefits may be obtained, and

WHEREAS, believing that the modifications will be in the best interests of the Program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT AGREED as follows:

1. Subsection 4(b) of Resolution No. 2002-976 is modified to hereinafter read as follows:

“b) Customer may obtain benefits only once during a calendar year. Benefits may not be obtained by a customer in successive years.”


2. Section 5 of Resolution No. 2002-976 is modified to hereinafter read as follows:


“Eligible customers shall be entitled to have funds applied to a delinquent water, or water and sewer, account. Subject to the limits expressed below, the funds shall be paid for benefit of curing a potential or actual account deficiency accrued during the four months prior to application for benefits. The ceiling for application of funds to an individual water or water and sewer account shall be 50% of the amount due, not to exceed \$100.


3. All other terms of Resolution No. 2002-976 not herein amended shall remain in full force and effect.
4. This amendment shall be effective on the date of adoption below.
5. The Board reserves the right to amend, suspend or cancel the provisions herein at any time.




