Resolution No. 2010-1156

A **RESOLUTION** of the Board of Commissioners of the Lakehaven Utility District, King County, Washington, adopting goals to reduce the emission of greenhouse gases.

WHEREAS, local governmental agencies throughout the United States are adopting energy and other resource conservation goals that will help reduce the emission of greenhouse gases, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners believes that the District should be a responsible participant in the efforts to improve the natural environment, and

WHEREAS, considering that the goals set forth below will contribute to the District's effective and efficient management of its resources and provide environmental and economic benefits that will serve the community;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Lakehaven Utility District hereby adopts the following goals to help reduce the emission of greenhouse gases:

1. The Board of Commissioners hereby adopts the following goals to help reduce the emission of greenhouse gases:
 - All new District buildings/facilities should consider energy efficiency in their design.
 - Energy conservation practices should be practiced to lower energy use in buildings and other facilities operated by the District.
 - The District should conduct energy audits of District owned buildings to evaluate, and implement, conservation measures as appropriate and cost effective.
 - Energy use for exterior lighting should be reduced by utilizing lighting standards and equipment that will assure safe and effective illumination at minimum cost and energy use.
 - Energy use for pumps used in water and sewer systems should be reduced by employing efficient operation and maintenance practices.
 - Energy consumption should be reduced through conservation and alternative energy forms to extend the life of existing facilities and infrastructure.

- The District should work with energy providers on specific, targeted outreach campaigns and, where permitted and cost effective, participate in incentive programs.
 - The District should establish a water conservation plan that includes conservation measures.
 - Water conservation will be practiced where appropriate and cost effective.
2. The Board of Commissioners reserves the authority to modify the provisions herein as it shall deem appropriate.
 3. This resolution shall be effective on the date of adoption below.

ADOPTED by the Board of Commissioners of Lakehaven Utility District, King County, Washington, at an open public meeting this 22nd day of April, 2010.




