Resolution No. 2011-1174

A **RESOLUTION** of the Board of Commissioners of the Lakehaven Utility District, King County, Washington, increasing the threshold for termination of water service on delinquent accounts from \$40.00 to \$60.00 and amending Section S (v) of Resolution No. 2010-1171.

WHEREAS, the Board has determined it prudent to terminate water service to water and combined water/sewer accounts with delinquent balances of \$40 or more, and

WHEREAS, the cost of terminating service as a collection practice is significant to both the District and customers, and

WHEREAS, the Board believing that increasing the threshold for terminating service will reduce overall service termination costs without negatively impacting collection efficiency;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. Section S (v) of Resolution No. 2010-1171 is amended to hereby read as follows:

Water service shall be turned off for all water and joint water and sewer accounts that have a past due balance of \$60.00, or more, after thirty days from the date of delinquency. Prior to resumption of water service, which shall be made only on request of the property owner, an additional charge in the amount of \$70.00 shall be collected if meter turn-on occurs on weekdays, except holidays, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. An additional charge of \$280.00 shall be charged prior to the resumption of service if meter turn-on occurs at any other time.

2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date following adoption below.


