Resolution No. 2011-1183

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of the Lakehaven Utility District, King County, Washington, modifying the Leak Adjustment Program and amending Section T (ii) of Resolution No. 2010-1171.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has established a program to reduce the cost of water leaked through the customer's water system where the leak is promptly repaired, and

WHEREAS, due to the nature of water leaks, the volume of water lost before discovery and repair of the leak can be significant, and

WHEREAS, with the District's inverted block rate structure, a significant portion of the water lost can be priced in the higher rate blocks, resulting in large bills for customers repairing leaks, and

WHEREAS, the Board believing it appropriate and in the best interests of the District and its customers to reduce the price of leaked water for customers repairing leaks:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. Section T (ii) of Resolution No. 2010-1171 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“ii) Subject to the conditions and limitations described below, where a customer shall repair a leak in their water system within thirty (30) days of discovery of the leak, whether discovery occurs by District notice or independent detection, the amount of water lost shall be reduced by 50%. The volume of water lost shall be determined by subtracting the water consumed during the corresponding period from the prior year from the volume of water registered by the water meter during the period of the leak. Following the reduction, the remaining water lost through the repaired leak shall be priced no higher than the second block rate. Water lost through a repaired leak will not be included in the wet month average for sewer system charges, or be otherwise charged in the sewer bill, and the District shall deduct the leaked water in the calculation of sewer system use associated with the sewer bill. Where a customer repairs a leak under the provisions herein, water leaked will not be included in the calculation of Capital Facilities Charge rental charges. No leak adjustment shall be made if the value of the leak adjustment is less than \$20.00.”

2. All other provisions of Resolution No. 2010-1171 not herein amended shall remain in full force and effect.

3. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of adoption below.
