Resolution No. 2022-1366

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of the Lakehaven Water and Sewer District, King County, Washington, adding “Juneteenth” as a paid holiday for District employees.

WHEREAS, in 2021, the State of Washington adopted the 19th day of June as an official state legal holiday, and

WHEREAS, the date, known as “Juneteenth”, celebrates the end of slavery in the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed whether to add Juneteenth as an additional paid holiday for District employees, and

WHEREAS, believing it in the best interests of the District to add Juneteenth as a paid holiday for District employees;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The Board hereby establishes June 19th, hereinafter to be known as “Juneteenth”, as an additional paid holiday for all District employees.
2. Juneteenth will be observed on June 19th each year, commencing in 2022. Where June 19th falls on a Saturday, Juneteenth shall be observed on Friday, June 18th. Where June 19th falls on a Sunday, Juneteenth shall be observed on Monday, June 20th.
3. Subject to any collective bargaining requirements, the Board reserves the authority to terminate Juneteenth as a paid holiday.
4. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of adoption set forth below.
