Resolution No. 94 - 756

**A RESOLUTION** of the Board of Commissioners of the Lakehaven Utility District, King County Washington, replacing the District's Conservation Program and cancelling Resolution No. 93-689

**WHEREAS**, the District is entrusted with the responsibility for securing and providing and adequate supply of water to its customers, and

**WHEREAS**, current and anticipated future demand on the system has and will reduce overall available supplies, and

**WHEREAS**, supplementary sources of water tend to be less economically and qualitatively viable as the existing groundwater sources, and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of the demand on the supply and the disadvantages associated with alternative sources, it is appropriate that the District emphasize an aggressive approach to water conservation, and

**WHEREAS**, The Board has previously adopted a Conservation Program in response to the problem of decreased water supplies,

**WHEREAS**, the Conservation Program contained a provision referencing the need for periodic review of the conservation measures discussed therein, and

**WHEREAS**, in evaluating the current state of the water supply, the Board has determined that a new program replacing the current Conservation Program is beneficial and necessary to protect the water resource, and

**WHEREAS**, the District being authorized to adopt and enforce water conservation measures pursuant to state law,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** as follows:

1. The Board hereby adopts the conservation measures set forth in the "Conservation Program", attached as an exhibit hereto and by this reference incorporated herein. The Conservation Program adopted herein shall replace in its entirety the existing program adopted pursuant to Resolution No. 93-689.
2. The Board shall undertake periodic review of the Conservation Program to ensure that it shall remain responsive to the requirements and conditions for maintaining an adequate supply of water and shall have the full authority to make any modifications to the Conservation Program as deemed necessary to protect the water supply.
3. Resolution No. 93-689 is hereby cancelled, effective on the adoption date of this resolution set forth below.
