Lakehaven has a service area population of over 135,000 people living across a 35 square mile area in south King County, making us the second largest special-purpose water and sewer district in the state. Our water system includes 450 miles of water mains, 25 active wells and 12 storage tanks, which allows us to meet a current annual average water demand of 10 million gallons per day (MGD) from the community. Lakehaven also has two wastewater treatment plants, 27 sewer lift stations, and 350 miles of sewer mains capable of collecting and treating up to 15.6 MGD. Our employees work hard to produce and treat high quality drinking water and to ensure treated wastewater adheres to EPA standards which safeguards the local ecological system of Puget Sound. If you want to work for an award-winning, innovative utility with competitive pay rates, career advancement and training opportunities, this is the right opportunity for you.

Employees in the Wastewater Operations Treatment Plant perform and/or assist with minor and major maintenance, repairs, and replacement of equipment and construction of supporting structures used in the wastewater treatment plants operated by the District. Assigned duties include but are not limited to: data collection, water quality monitoring/treatment and sampling, process control work,

grounds/building maintenance, piping/valve/pump repairs and other preventative and corrective maintenance duties within the facilities. Position placement and pay is dependent upon experience and qualifications.

- Prior wastewater internship experience is desired.
- Wastewater Operator Certification Course – Must submit proof of enrollment prior to interview.

- A valid Washington State Competency certificate “Group I – OIT” as a Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator must be obtained within one (1) year from initial employment.
